

- BrightEye™ DualPath - Two Signals in a Single Path







IP Connection LAN, VPN, **Public Internet** The DualPath signal, carrying two videos and associated audio, travels as a single feed over an ordinary path. DualPath operates only at the end points, with no changes required to the existing link.

This example shows an IP link utilizing MPEG compresion, but DualPath works equally well with baseband SDI and Fiber connections.

The left and right halves of the mulitplexed signal are expanded back to their correct dimensions.



Set the Audio Receive mode to match transmission.



The compressed output is still an 'ordinary' baseband video signal.

DualPath adds two more

destinations for signal routing.
